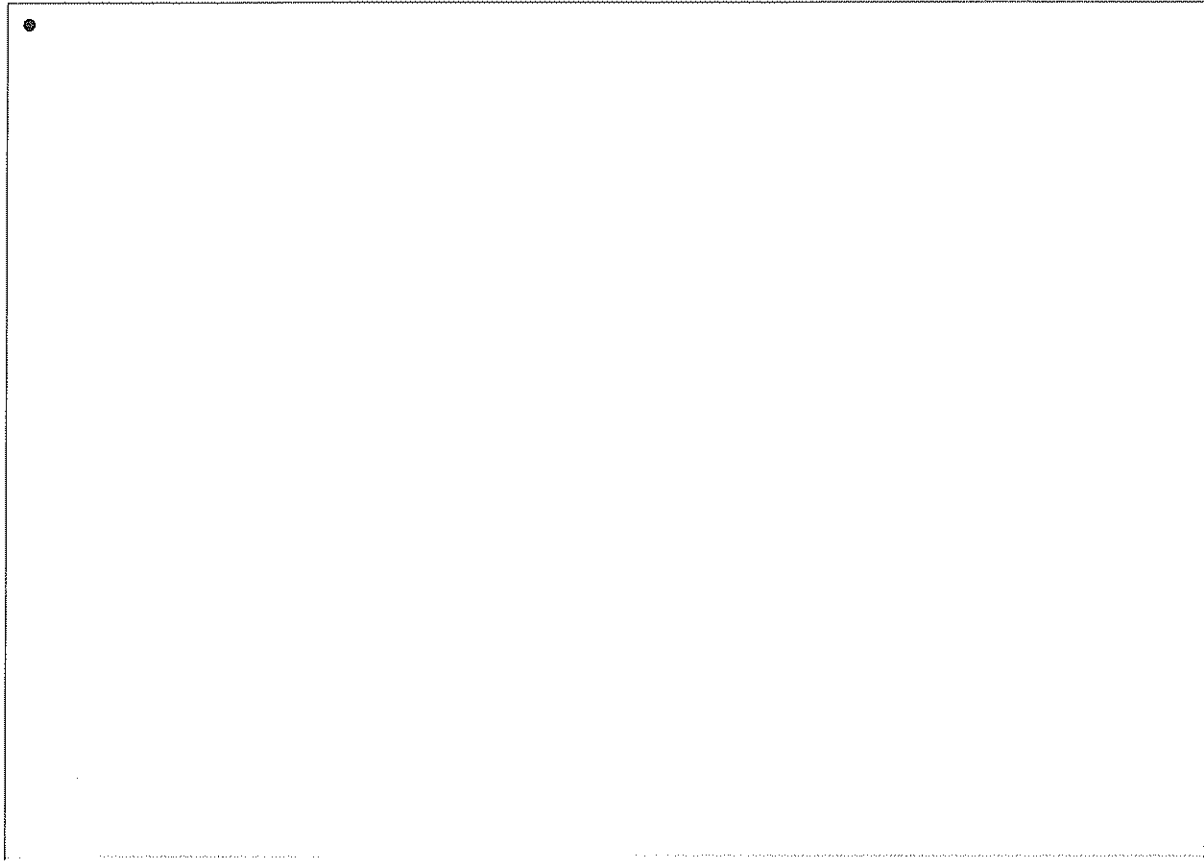

See if graphs work now? I added Blue Ridge data also in this one. -R

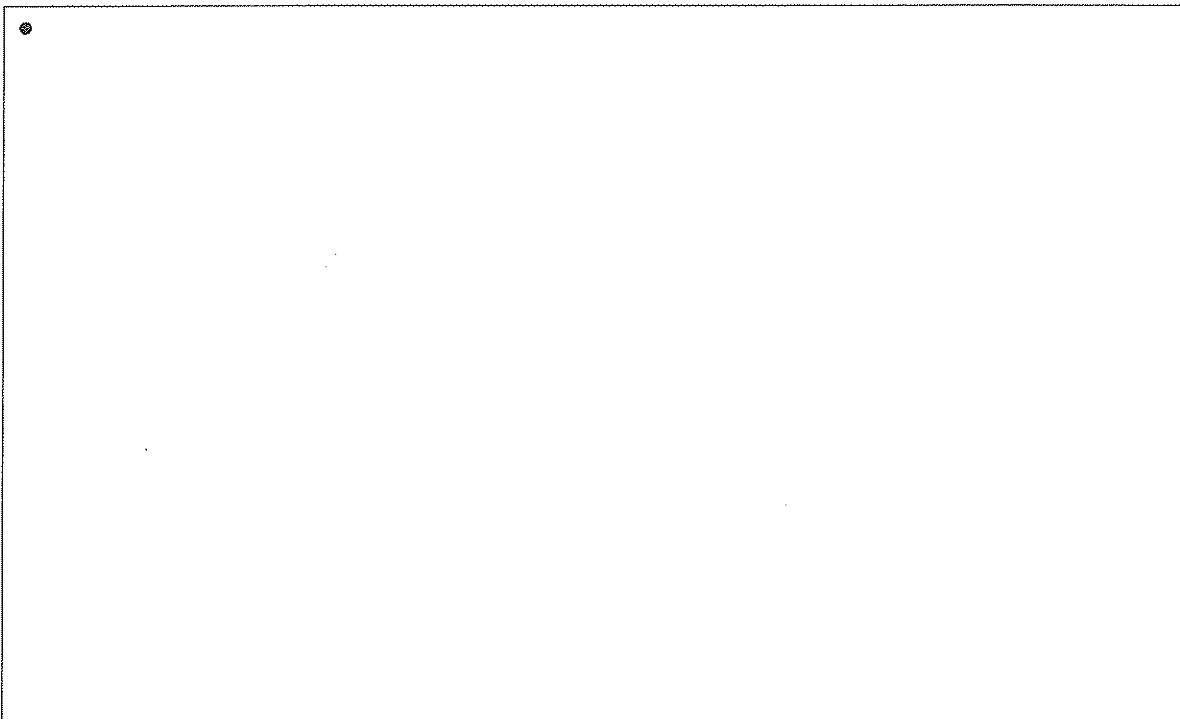

Respiratory Viruses Report  
Week Ending November 16, 2009

- There were 3 positive Influenza A tests found this week at Mission out of a total of 60 tests performed.
- 18 tests were performed at Transylvania Hospital with no positives
- Blue Ridge reports 21 tests performed with 2 positive for Influenza A
- North Carolina remains at "widespread" influenza activity. The state reported, for last week, 547 hospitalizations and 2 deaths. A total of 45 deaths in North Carolina have been confirmed H1N1 related.

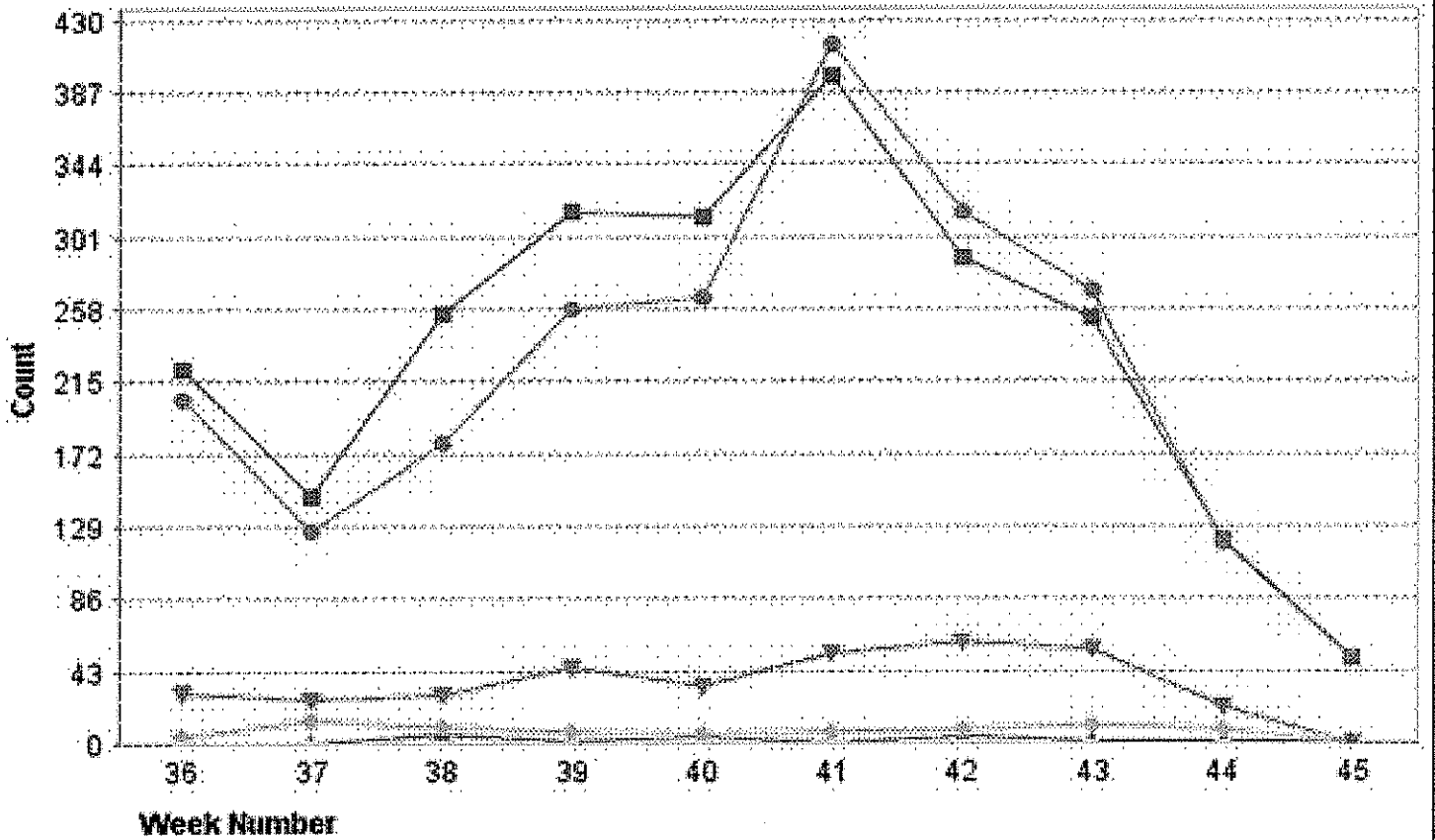

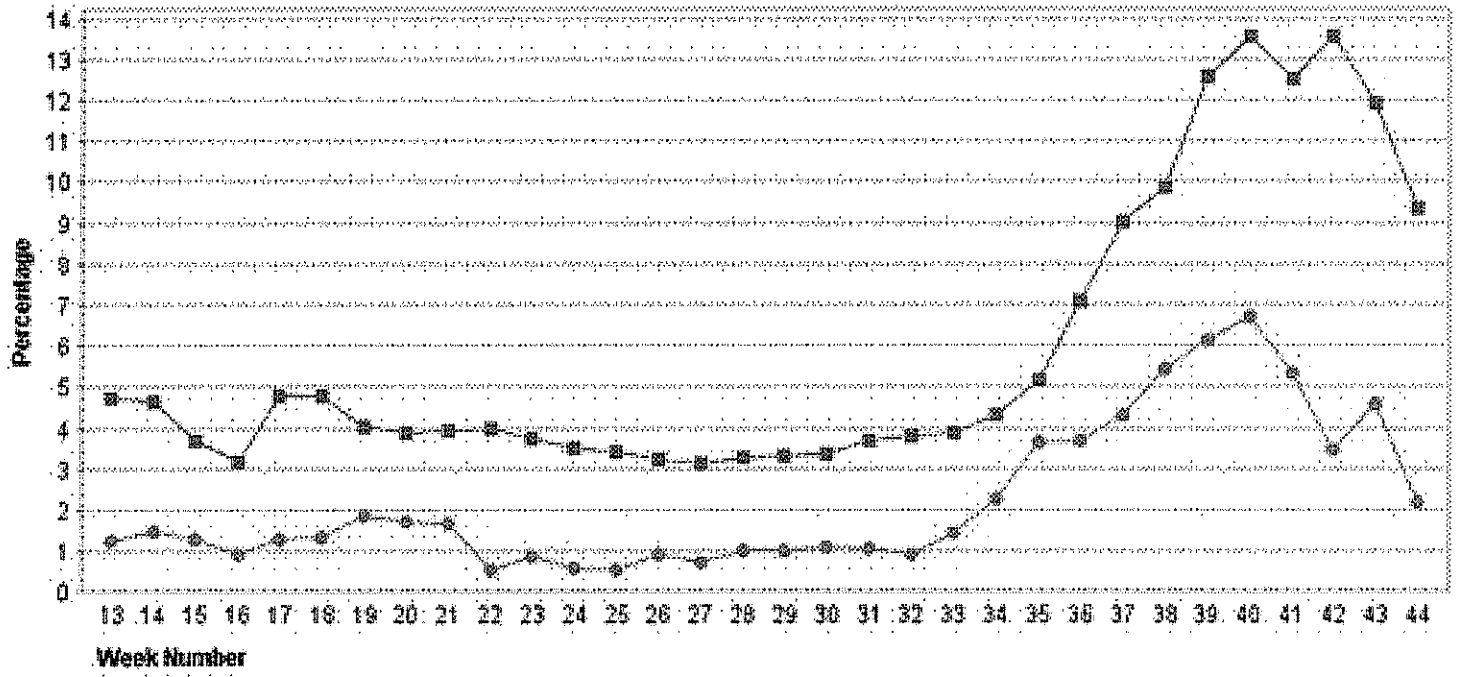
Legend: Total Positive, A Positive, B Positive, AH1 Positive, AH3 Positive, Confirmed Novel H1N1
