



COMPREHENSIVE CHILD HEALTH PROGRAM REVIEW & DPH CONSULTATION SUPPORT PROCESS

I. Agreement Addenda Development

- ✓ The Branch establishes outcome indicators and accountability process
- ✓ *Section C funds* are linked to the community strategies defined in the Program Review

III. Local Health Department Program Review

- ✓ Nurse consultants from the Best Practices Unit will conduct an onsite two component Child Health (CH) Program Review
 - Review of CH clinical services & policies & procedures
 - Review of local community data: Community Level CH Impact Indicators
- ✓ Agency staff and consultant will discuss findings and develop an Action Plan and implementation timeline to address findings of the Program Review
- ✓ Agency staff and the consultant will use the self-assessment, Community Level CH Impact Indicators, and Program Review findings to analyze and define community child health issues

II. Local Health Department Self Assessment

- ✓ Prior to the Program Review, agency staff perform a self assessment of five clinical records from the current fiscal year for each CH programs, CH policies and procedures, and the Community Level CH Impact Indicators

IV. Action Plan Implementation Strategy and Systems Building (*Ongoing Consultation*)

- ✓ Agency staff and the nurse consultants from the Health & Wellness Unit will work with the LHD to develop strategies to leverage available LHD, local child health agency, and the Community Cares Network resources to address the identified child health issues
- ✓ Child Health Nurse Consultants from the Health & Wellness Unit will provide technical assistance and consultation to support the implementation of the Action Plan resulting from Program Review findings and the defined community strategies to address child health issues
- ✓ Consultative support will include assistance with care coordination and systems building, identification of state and local data, expertise and support, and skills training
